PART 2. OBJECTIVES

Main objectives of the meeting were to discuss the work progress with the special emphasis to the analysis of the research potential and to finalize the form and content of the questionnaire describing research potential in the participating countries.

PART 3. DISCUSSION

Discussion has been initiated by prof. Jacek Jagielski. A short presentation has been shown pointing to the main topics addressed in the frames of WP1. A first draft of the key points of the questionnaire have been presented as well. The presentation has been concluded with the list of approaching deliverables and milestones in WP1.

After the presentation a vivid discussion about the content of the questionnaire has been initiated. Finally we agreed that the questionnaire will contain the following points:

1. Name of organization, contact data, logo, web page, photograph
2. Type (research, academic, industry)
3. Basic figures (number of employees, address, contact data, supervisory organization, ...)
4. Main activities of the institution
5. Main projects in past five years (national, EU, industrial, others)
6. Link to Annual Report (if available)
7. Contact data
8. Membership in international nuclear research programs and societies
9. Main research (experimental and analytical) equipment: all, available for external partners
10. Main access rules: participation in experiments and physical access (security)
11. Free description (could include scientific metrics: number of publication per year, institution Hirsch factor)

It has been agreed also, that only major players in the field of nuclear technology (important for nuclear power technology) will be included in the analysis.

The meeting has been concluded with the list of actions that should be undertaken in the next few months.

PART 4. CONCLUSIONS

Main outcome of the meeting was the consensus about description of the research potential in participating countries. Current topics connected with WP1 realization were discussed as well. Next WP1 meeting is planned to be held in Warsaw, at the occasion of joint seminar organized in Ministry of Energy in 2016.
